Lake Report

As we approach warmer weather, there is more activity of homeowners enjoying the lake. The water quality is, once again, good since we have had cooler weather and sufficient rain. We expect the same algae problems this summer since the Dept. of Ecology (DOE) will not allow the use of copper sulfate to treat Washington lakes and we can not afford to treat with aluminum sulfate. In addition, there are other issues and questions that come with the application of aluminum sulfate. We would like to be able to use the lake this summer so if any homeowner knows any avenues to influence the DOE on this important issue, we would love to hear from you.

There have been many people fishing and, yes, even without a stocking of fish this year, fish are being caught! It also has been reported that many "baby" trout have been seen as well.

There have been posted signs that have been removed or defaced. These signs are required to be posted by our insurance company for safety, release of liability issues and to maintain the quality of our facilities. Any person(s) caught removing or defacing posted signs, without explicit written consent by the board, could face "destruction of property" charges.

We hope that many of you get a chance to enjoy our lake, which is a great asset to our community. The islands have been trimmed and are accessible for your enjoyment. The beach has a great view of Mt. Rainier. So, if you haven't been down to the lake lately, you should make a point to check it out. Happy Spring!!
