Lake Jane Lifeguard Job Description

The Lake Jane Pool Committee is looking for lifeguards who will create a safe and positive atmosphere that welcomes and respects all Lake Jane Members and their guests while maintaining safe swimming conditions in the pool, deck and surrounding areas.

Essential Functions

- 1. Maintains active surveillance of the Pool area.
- 2. Knows and reviews all emergency procedures and responds to emergency situations immediately.
- 3. Responds to challenges with possible solutions in a timely manner.
- 4. Knows, understands and consistently applies safety rules, policies and guidelines for the pool.
- 5. Remains calm and objective when under pressure or when challenged by others.
- 6. Check the pool for hazardous conditions when arriving and monitor throughout the shift.
- 7. Performs chemical testing when not guarding, as required and takes appropriate action.
- 8. Supervises pool hut workers and helps to ensure that the pool and facilities are being maintained throughout their shift.
- 9. Completes incident and accident reports as necessary
- 10. Communicates effectively with the Pool Committee and Facility Manager.
- 11. Checks in members and their guests (verifying membership)
- 12. Friendly guest interaction in person and over the phone.
- 13. Responsible and accurate use of the cash register and cash handling
- 14. Cleans, sanitizes and organizes the pool hut area and does routine checks of cleanliness of pool deck, tables, and pool toys.
- 15. Maintains and cleans bathroom facilities, including toilets, sinks, benches, and floors. Floors should also be monitored for standing water and squeegeed as needed.
- 16. Completes all checklist duties as assigned
- 17. Responsible for the cash drawer and deposits at the end of shift.
- 18. Responsible for cleanliness of facilities. Cleans and stocks facilities as needed and at the end of shift.
- 19. Ensures that all swimmers have an emergency card on file
- 20. Locks up and securs facilities at the end of shift.
- 21. Other duties as assigned.

Qualifications

- -Minimum age of 16
- -American Red Cross Lifeguard Certified (or equivalent)
- -Ability to maintain certification-level physical and mental readiness.
- -Must be able to demonstrate lifeguard skills at all times.
- -Must be able to attend mandatory training dates.

WORK Environment & Physical Demands

- The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job.
- Physically perform all skills required of a lifeguard.
- Hear noises and distress signals in the aquatic environment, including in the water and anywhere around the zone of responsibility.
- Remain alert with no lapses of consciousness.
- See and observe all sections of an assigned zone or area of responsibility.
- Ability to pass a swim competency test.
